Nextiles, Inc. (“Nextiles”) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your data. This Website Privacy Notice describes the types of data that Nextiles collects from and about you when you visit our website, www.nextiles.tech (the “Website”). 1. SCOPE AND OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This Website Privacy Notice describes the types of data that Nextiles collects from and about you when you visit our Website. It does not apply to data that Nextiles collects from and about you through your use of Nextiles products or applications, and it does not apply to data that you provide when you become an employee of Nextiles, each of which is subject to a separate privacy notice.

It is important that you read this Website Privacy Notice together with any other privacy notice or fair processing notice that we may provide on specific occasions when we are collecting or processing personal data from or about you so that you are fully aware of how and why we are using your data.

This Website is not intended for children, and we do not knowingly collect information from children.

2. DATA THAT WE COLLECT

We collect some information automatically from visitors to our Website, and we collect additional information if and when you choose to share it with us.

- **Data That We Collect Automatically**

- o *Technical Information.* When you visit our Website, we may automatically collect certain technical information, such as the domain from which you accessed the internet, your Internet Protocol (IP) address, your device’s operating system and browser type, the date and time of your visit, the content you visited or downloaded, and the referral source that connected you to our Website. Most browsers automatically transmit this type of technical information to the websites that you visit, and we collect this information in order to administer our website, to ensure that it functions properly for

different users with different browsers and operating systems, and to obtain and review website-related statistics and information so that we can provide a better experience.

- o *Cookies.* A cookie is an element of data that a website can send to your browser, which may then store it on your system. Some cookies are necessary, in that they enable basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. Others are optional, but very useful, in that they help website operators understand how visitors interact with their websites by collecting and reporting website use information anonymously to the operator. Our Website uses one necessary cookie and two optional cookies. We have not given you the option to decline our necessary cookie, but the two optional cookies are disabled by default; we only start to use them if you click “Accept” on the Cookie Banner that appears at the bottom of your screen upon your first visit to our website. - o *Analytics.* We use tools provided by Google Analytics to process and review the technical information that we collect from website visitors, as detailed above, as well as the information that we obtain through our use of cookies. These tools allow us to review anonymized, aggregated data about our website traffic in an easy-to-read format. - **Data That You Choose to Share with Us**

- o We will also collect information about you through our Website if you provide that information to us voluntarily by completing our contact form or signing up for updates from us. In that case, the information we collect will be the information that you provide to us, often including your first name, last name, email address, the name of your company, and a short description of your issue or request. When you share your information with us through our contact form, we use a third-party service provider, SendInBlue, to deliver that message to a team member’s email inbox. 3. DATA USE AND OUR LEGAL BASIS

Nextiles is committed to protecting and maintaining the privacy of your data. Therefore, we will process your data only in accordance with applicable data protection law and this Website Privacy Notice.

We will have a lawful basis for processing your data if:

- We need to process your data to provide you with the service that you have requested, or to enter into a contract;
- You have consented to such processing;
- We have a legitimate interest in processing your data, and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests – e.g., for network and information systems security; data analytics; enhancing modifying, or improving our services; identifying usage trends; determining the effectiveness of our marketing; and/or
- We are legally obliged to process it.

We may use the data that we collect from and about you for any of the following purposes:

- To respond to your inquiries and contact and communicate with you when requested;
- To review the usage and operations of the Website, and to conduct analysis to enhance or improve our content or services;
- To contact you with information and promotional materials from Nextiles or on behalf of our affiliates;
- To address problems with the Website or our business, and to protect the security or integrity of the Website and our business; and
- For other purposes disclosed at the time you provide your information or otherwise with your consent.

4. DATA THAT WE SHARE

Except as provided in this Website Privacy Notice, Nextiles does not disclose, sell, rent, or exchange any personal data collected from or about you through our Website to or with any unrelated third parties. However, Nextiles may share the data that we collect from or about you in the following ways:

- **With our Service Providers:** As noted above, and as otherwise may be necessary from time to time, we may share your data with third-party service providers that provide business, professional, or technical support functions for us, help us operate our business and the Website, or administer activities on our behalf.
- **Legal Obligations; Safety:** We may disclose your data to respond to subpoenas, judicial processes, or government requests and investigations, or in connection with an investigation on matters related to public safety, as permitted by law, or otherwise as required by law. We may disclose your data to protect the security of our Website, servers, network systems, and databases. We may disclose your data, as necessary, if we believe that there has been a violation of any legal document or contract related to our services, or the rights of any third party.
- **Sale or Transfer of Business or Assets:** We may sell or purchase assets during the normal course of our business. If another entity acquires us or any of our assets, information that we have collected about you may be transferred to such entity. In addition, if any bankruptcy or reorganization proceeding is brought by or against us, such data may be considered an asset of ours and may be sold or transferred to third parties. Should such a sale or transfer occur, we will use reasonable efforts to try to require that the transferee use personal data provided through this Website in a manner that is consistent with this Website Privacy Notice.

5. DATA RETENTION

We will keep your personal data for as long as we need it to fulfill the purpose it is being processed for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, we consider the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which we process your personal data, and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements.

6. YOUR RIGHTS AND CHOICES

- **Your Rights**

Under certain circumstances, you have rights under data protection laws in relation to your personal data. Further information and advice about your rights can be obtained from the data protection authority in your state or in your country. For example:

- o *Right to be informed.* You have the right to be provided with clear, transparent, and easily understandable information about how we use your information and your rights. This is why we are providing you with this Website Privacy Notice.
- o *Right of Access.* You have the right to obtain access to your data (if we are processing it), and certain other information (similar to that provided in this Website Privacy Notice). This is so you are aware and can check that we are using your data in accordance with relevant data protection laws.
- o *Right to Rectification.* You are entitled to have your data corrected if it is inaccurate or incomplete.
- o *Right to Erasure.* This is also known as ‘the right to be forgotten’ and, in simple terms, enables you to request the deletion or removal of your data where there is no compelling reason for us to keep it. This is not a general right; there are exceptions.
- o *Right to Restrict Processing.* You have certain rights to ‘block’ or suppress further use of your data. When processing is restricted, we can still store your data, but we may not use it further. We keep lists of people who have asked for further use of their data to be ‘blocked’ to make sure the restriction is respected in future.
- o *Right to Object to Processing.* You have the right to object to certain types of processing, including processing for direct marketing purposes.
- o *Right to Lodge a Complaint.* You have the right to lodge a complaint about the way we handle or process your personal data with your national data protection authority.
- o *Right to Withdraw Consent.* If you have given your consent to anything we do with your personal data, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time (although if you do so, it does not mean that anything we have done with your personal data with your consent up to that point is unlawful). This includes your right to withdraw consent to us for use of your personal data for marketing purposes.

If you have these rights under your data protection laws, you can exercise your rights by using the details set out in the ‘How to Contact Us’ section below.

Pursuant to applicable data protection law, we may be entitled to refuse to act on the request. In addition, please be advised that the data we collect through our website is limited, as set forth above, particularly if you have not chosen to contact us by submitting a form inquiry. For example, we can only access and view technical information on our website visitors in an aggregated and anonymized form, and we are therefore unable to provide user-specific usage details back to any particular user.

- ***Opt-Out Preferences***

If you subscribe through our Website to receive updates from us, and you later decide you no longer want to receive those updates, you may opt-out of receiving them at any time by:

For California Residents: As noted above, our Website uses one necessary cookie. We do not collect personal information about your online activities over time and across third-party sites for tracking purposes. We do not allow third parties to collect personal information on our website that could be used by them to analyze and store information about your online activities over time and across third-party sites for tracking purposes. As such, our website does not respond to any "DO NOT TRACK" signals that may be sent from your browser or device.

7. YOUR CALIFORNIA PRIVACY RIGHTS

10. INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

Nextiles is headquartered in Brooklyn, New York, and we are a U.S. business. When you use our Website, or submit an inquiry to us through our Website, you are transferring information to us. That information will be stored on our computers and on computers belonging to our service providers, which may be located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction, and where the data protection laws may differ from those in your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction. When you use our website or choose to contact us, you are consenting to the transfer of the information you provide to us to our jurisdiction.
